SELECTION PROCESS FOR NOMINATIONS:

1. Deadline for submission of this year's nominations: **received by October 1, 2020.**
Nominations may be received by mail, delivery service, or email.
2. Deadline for the Hall of Fame Committee to recommend each year's Inductees to the MSA Executive Director will be no later than **October 1, 2020.**
3. Deadline for the Executive Director to notify inductees will be no later than **November 15, 2020.**
4. Hall of Fame Inductees will be presented and honored at the 2021 Mississippi Soccer Awards Banquet in January.

GENERAL CRITERIA:

1. Nominations for persons to be inducted into the Mississippi Soccer Hall of Fame may be submitted by any person who has been or is a player, coach, referee, or administrator for Mississippi Soccer, an Organization Member of Mississippi Soccer, or a member of an Organization Member. All resumes shall be typed on the Resume form attached to this Mississippi Soccer Hall of Fame Nomination Form.
2. The recognition must be for significant personal achievement in, or contribution to, Mississippi Soccer at the State Level. In addition, the demonstrated, positive effect of



such achievement or contribution must have set a clear and recognized example for the soccer community to emulate and regard as a model to be followed for personal achievement.

3. Players - must have reached the minimum age of 22 and have distinguished themselves with an outstanding standard of play and/or performance as a member of Mississippi Soccer. The player must have participated in youth games as a registered member of Mississippi Soccer for at least 6 consecutive years.
4. Administrators, Referees, Coaches, etc. - must have demonstrated outstanding accomplishments and/or leadership that have made significant contributions to the improvement of the sport and its participants nationwide. They must have contributed directly for a period of 6 or more years at the State level of Mississippi Soccer.
5. Meritorious Recognition - Nominations for this Recognition are for individuals or organizations involved in the support of Mississippi Soccer in non-playing, non-administrative, non-coaching, and non-refereeing capacities.

Completed nomination forms shall be sent to the Mississippi Soccer National Office and must be received no later than October 1, 2020.
